Alkathon

Amy – District 18/19 PI Chair, Area Public Information

- Radio Campaigns
- Last year district 18/19 ran 3-month radio campaign WBOQ (104.9) \$3000 to run radio announcements during the holidays (Nov-Jan), 10-15 ads/week bulk during the weekends
- There were 3 different PSA's all came out of NY
- Went well got some minor feedback that they were appropriate, useful
- This year they are trying to run campaign July -January. Committee is visiting Districts to ask for \$ to fund the campaign for this timeframe. Visiting districts where this radio station can be heard.
- Districts 18/19 are contributing \$1,500, they already have \$500 the whole campaign will cost \$6,000 the radio station is giving us some extra airtime as well. They will also allow us to go on air and talk about what AA is. PSA's to carry the message to alcoholics who still suffer and let them know that AA exists.
- They also want to run ads on ERS, NEX and other stations at various stations at other times of the year.
- The campaign would not go forward unless we were able to raise all \$6,000.

o Monthly impressions: 195,000 reach

Overall past campaign reached: 300,000
